The Cross

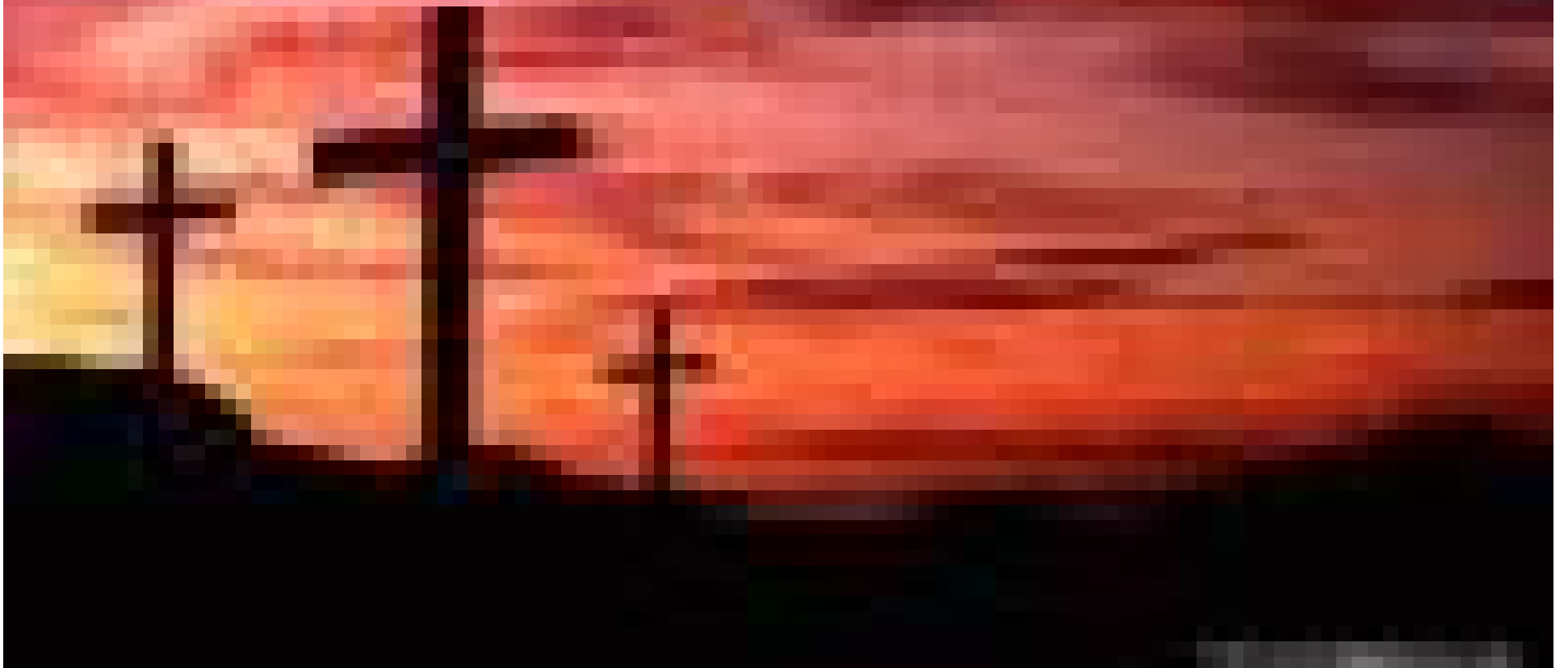
- Jesus died on the cross, but what did that mean?
