We sincerely appreciate your efforts helping us attack childhood hunger in Grand Rapids. Below is a short list of "need to knows" before your session. Also, we would appreciate it if you would fill out the Volunteer Information form at the bottom of this page and bring it to your session.

- When you arrive at KFB, there will be a volunteer facilitator or staff member to greet you and help run your session. Your group will also most likely be working alongside two other groups during your session.
- The majority of the jobs at KFB require standing, so we recommend wearing comfortable shoes.
- KFB uses peanut products for many of the items in our sack suppers. Please let us know in advance if anyone has peanut allergies so we can plan accordingly and make sure our activities keep everyone happy and healthy!
- We are not able to allow school bus parking in our lot. Parking is available in the alley on the west side of our building.
- KFB welcomes *on-site* volunteers (ages kindergarten and up) to participate in our many different activities.
 - To ensure the safety of all of our volunteers, we ask that children younger than Kindergarten age not accompany the group on site. However, we encourage these younger volunteers to participate in *off-site* projects, such as bag decorating, so they, too, can make a difference in another child's life.
- Because we want everyone's experience to be as perfect as possible, the size of your group matters.
 - Bringing more than your confirmed number could get you done early, while bringing less could compromise your ability to get the job done.
 - Please try to keep your group size as close to the confirmed number as possible. If your group number changes significantly, please contact KFB as soon as possible.

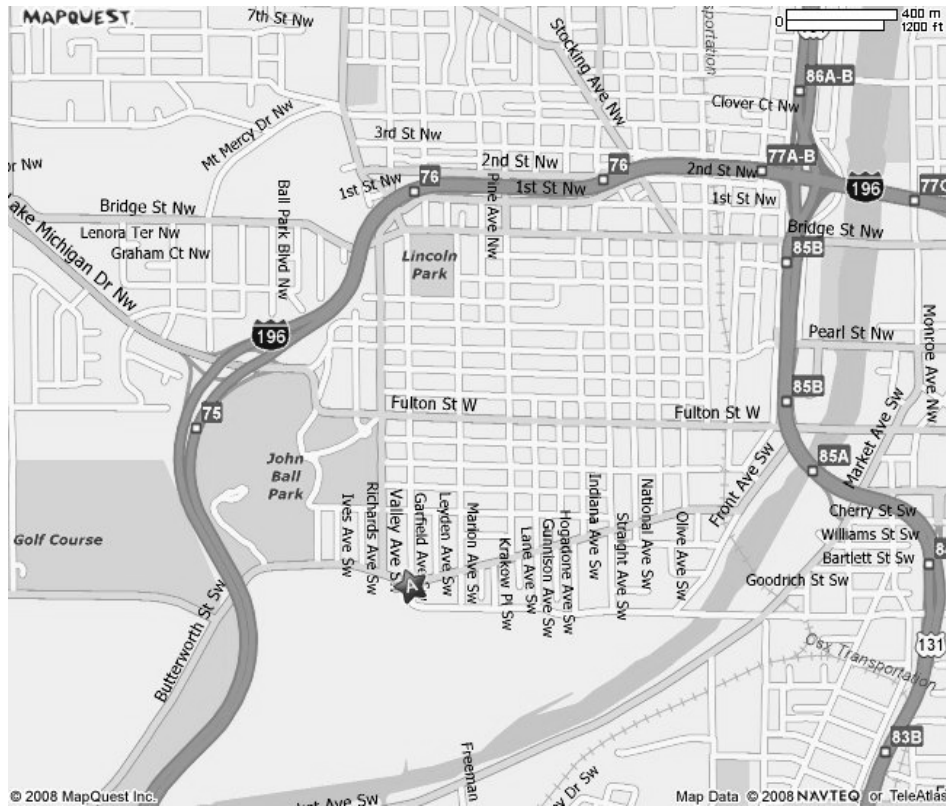

How Do We Get There??



Kids' Food Basket is located at 1203 Butterworth SW, Grand Rapids, MI 49504

Coming from the North:

Take 131-South to 196-West toward Holland (exit 86B). Get off 196 at Lane Avenue (exit 76). Make a left on Lane Avenue, a right on Fulton Street, a left on Garfield, and a right into the parking lot located on Garfield.

Coming from the South:

Take 131-North to Wealthy Street (exit 84A). Make a left onto Wealthy Street. There is a 4-way stop at Butterworth; proceed through the intersection and immediately turn left into the parking lot located on Garfield. Wealthy Street becomes Garfield.

Coming from the East:

Take 96-West to 196-West (exit 37). Get off 196 at Lane Avenue (exit 76). Make a left on Lane Avenue, a right on Fulton Street, a left on Garfield, and a right into the parking lot located on Garfield.

Coming from the West:

Take 196-East to Lake Michigan Drive (exit 75). Take the M 45-East ramp and make a slight right onto Lake Michigan Drive. Keep to the right where Lake Michigan Drive splits to Fulton Street. Pass the John Ball Park Zoo. The light is Valley Street; pass that and turn right on Garfield, then right into the parking lot located on Garfield.

*Additional parking is available across the street at Coca-Cola. Enter off of Wealthy (Garfield).
